About the Project

“EduStorytelling” (EST) aims at addressing the digital skills and literacy gap affecting European adults coming from disadvantaged backgrounds through the methodology of Digital Storytelling (DST) as a pathway to develop high-quality digital and literacy skills and competencies. It will improve attitudes of peer-interaction and cooperative learning, forming part of a comprehensive digital literacy in order to foster personal development, active citizenship and employability perspectives.

Updates and news on the project

First, the Newsletter give an insight about the IO1 done. The Training Handbook is designed as a tool to enhance digital skills of adult education trainers working with adults with a disadvantaged background.

Second, give more information about the JSTE, which took place from 26.07.2021 - 03.08.2021 in Stintino, Italy. The activities included: team building activity so that the participants would start to open up to the group and feel welcomed, ice-breaking games, energizer , coach-led tournament, workshops, and finally evaluation and impact assessment of digital storytelling. MVI introduced the contents of the IO2, that will be implemented after the mobility that will take place in spring 2021 to produce the DigiStories Guide.
