About the Project

“EduStorytelling” (EST) aims at addressing the digital skills and literacy gap affecting European adults coming from disadvantaged backgrounds through the methodology of Digital Storytelling (DST) as a pathway to develop high-quality digital and literacy skills and competencies. It will improve attitudes of peer-interaction and cooperative learning, forming part of a comprehensive digital literacy in order to foster personal development, active citizenship and employability perspectives.

Updates and news on the project

The project partners started to work on IO1 - Curriculum on Digital Storytelling in Adult Education".

It has been decided that 60% of the budget for the mobility will be redirected to an IO, because of the COVID-19 outbreak that slowed down the whole process. The partners took part in an assessment session guided by the IO leader, CRN, on the template shared after last meeting. Partners clarified the content, the structure and the learning path to be implemented and agreed on having short one-on-one meetings, with the partners having the following module in order to avoid overlapping of activities.

Information of the modules will start from the best practices and using them to schedule the activities for a one-day training.

MVI introduced the contents of the IO2, that will be implemented after the mobility that will take place in spring 2021 to produce the DigiStories Guide. In the meantime, MVI supervised by Autocreacja will draft a structure of the Guide. This way, once all the info from the mobility will be collected it will be easier and faster to create the content of the guide, leading to an end of the IO2 by June 2021.

In the next meeting, partners will also lay the basics for the development of the IO3, according to the COVID-19 situation partners will try to select a possible date for the mobility to take place.



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
